Alstonville High School - Organisation from 11th May 2020

Dear Parents/Carers

As you are aware the Department of Education has indicated that from Week 3 students will be returning to school 1 day per week (in what they call phase 1).

Social distancing is still expected and the finer details on how this will work particularly in classrooms is still being discussed. At this point, we can only have about 10 students per classroom.

We intend having Year 12 and 11 (senior) students on site 2 days per week, and Year 7 -10 (junior) students on site 1 day per week. The arrangements will be as follows:-

Monday –	Year 12 Year 7 – 10 students whose Surname starts with A – D
Tuesday -	Year 11 Year 7 – 10 students whose Surname starts with E – K
Wednesday -	Students of essential workers only.
Thursday -	Year 12 Year 7 – 10 students whose Surname starts with L – R

Friday - Year 11

Year 7 – 10 students whose Surname starts with S – Z

The reasoning behind Year 7 to 10 being split across surnames is to help families with multiple students, so they attend on the same day.

Seniors will have six 50 minute lessons per day (this ensures each line/subject is taught). The expectation is that students will be on site in class on their allocated days, as this will be how content will be delivered. (No zoom lessons.) We are still discussing how/when extension classes will operate.

Juniors whether at school or home will still receive their units of work for each subject as online learning modules and when at school will be supervised by staff each day. Junior students will be required to bring technology or hard copies of their work to school each day. If using their own device they will need to have downloaded it onto the device as they may not have WIFI access.

Further details will be sent as we get closer to the return date.
